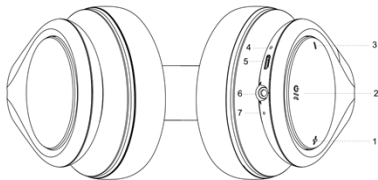

INSTRUCTIONS

SWITCHING HEADSET ON/OFF

- To turn on headset, press and hold the multi-function button for about 3 seconds until the LED starts flashing and voice prompt says "Power on".
- To turn off headset, again press and hold the multi-function button for about 3 seconds, until the LED starts flashing and voice prompt says "Power off".

CALL FUNCTION

- Answering a call: Press the multi-function button once to answer an incoming call
- Ending a call: Press the multi-function button once to end an ongoing call
- Redial Function: Under standby mode, double press the multi-function button to redial the last dialed call
- Reject Call: Press and hold the multi-function button for 2 seconds during an incoming call

USING THE WIRED MODE

- Plug in the 3.5mm cable into headset, and the other end into your Line-Out port of your device
- The headset will automatically start playing in Wired media mode

ADJUSTING VOLUME AND CONTROLLING MUSIC PLAYBACK

- Volume Control: Long press the Volume "+" button to increase the volume, Long press the Volume "-" button to decrease the volume.
- Music Play/Pause: During standby mode, short press the Multi- Function button once to play music. Again short press the Multi-Function button to pause the ongoing track.
- Navigating Through Tracks: While playing music, short press and hold the Volume "+" button once to skip to the next track Short press the Volume "-" button once to skip to the previous track.

CHARGING HEADSET

- Plug one end of the charging cable into headset charging input and the other end into a USB Power Adapter or a Laptop/Desktop.
- The Red LED turns on to indicate that your headset is charging.
- Once completely charged the LED will turn off.
- For your safety, it is recommended that you refrain from using the headset while it is charging.

PAIRING YOUR PRODUCT

- Before connecting headset to your device, make sure that headset is in pairing mode. In order to enter pairing mode, press and hold the multi- function button for 6 seconds until Red and Blue LED start flashing alternatively and voice prompt says "Pairing"
- Turn on the Bluetooth function of the device you wish to connect and search for " AA-2129 ". From the list of found devices, select.
- Headset is now connected to your device

TROUBLESHOOTING

If the headset does not pair with a Bluetooth device: Check if the Bluetooth hardware on your device supports A2DP profile which is necessary for sound transmission over Bluetooth.
